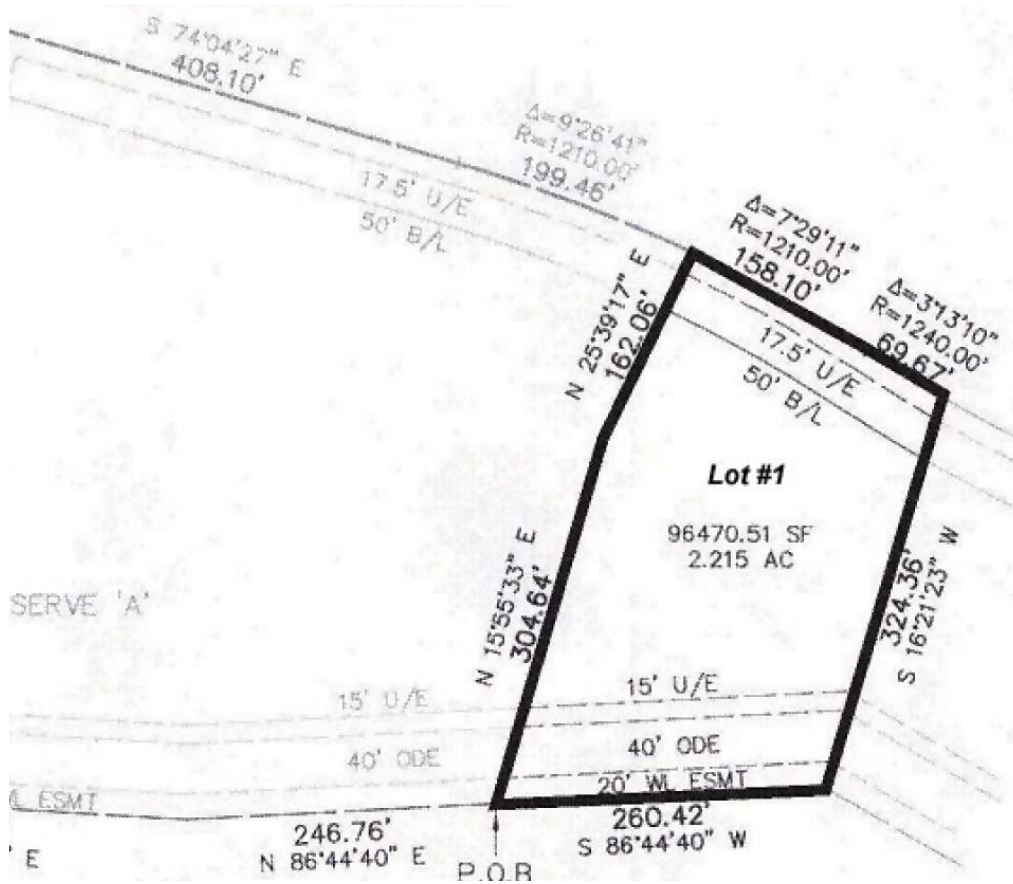

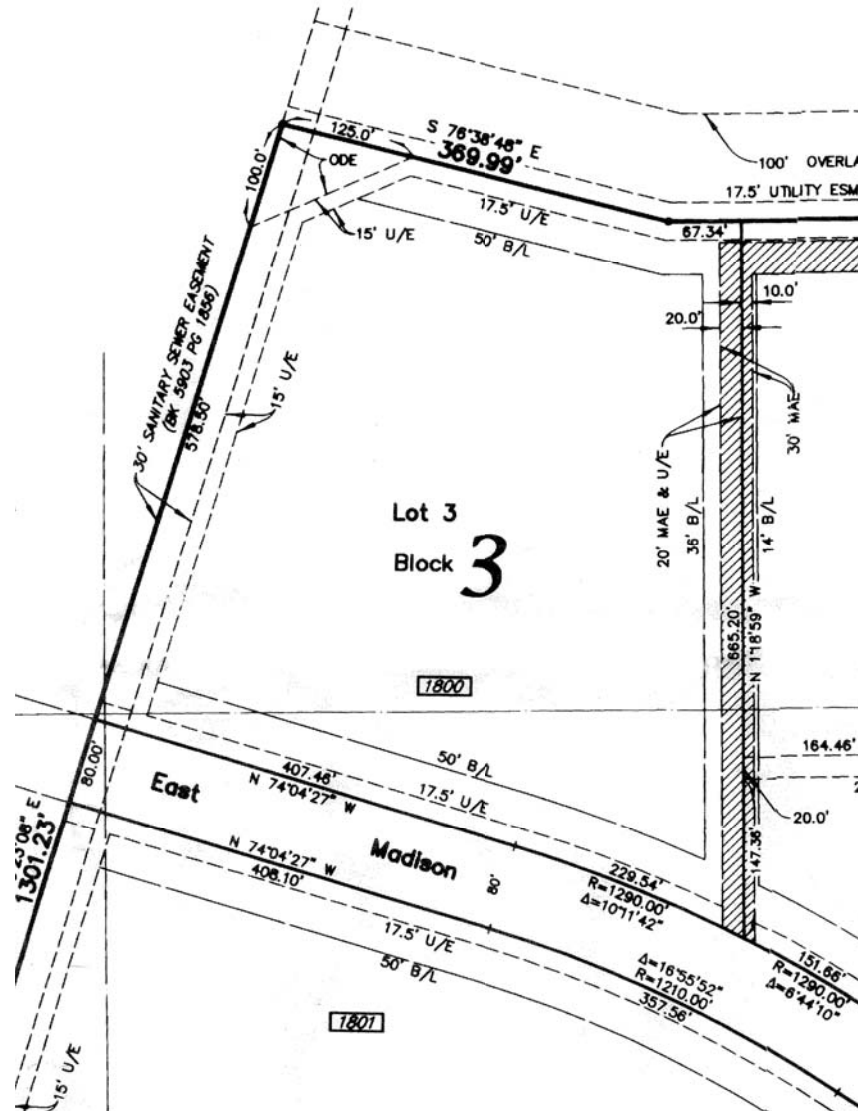

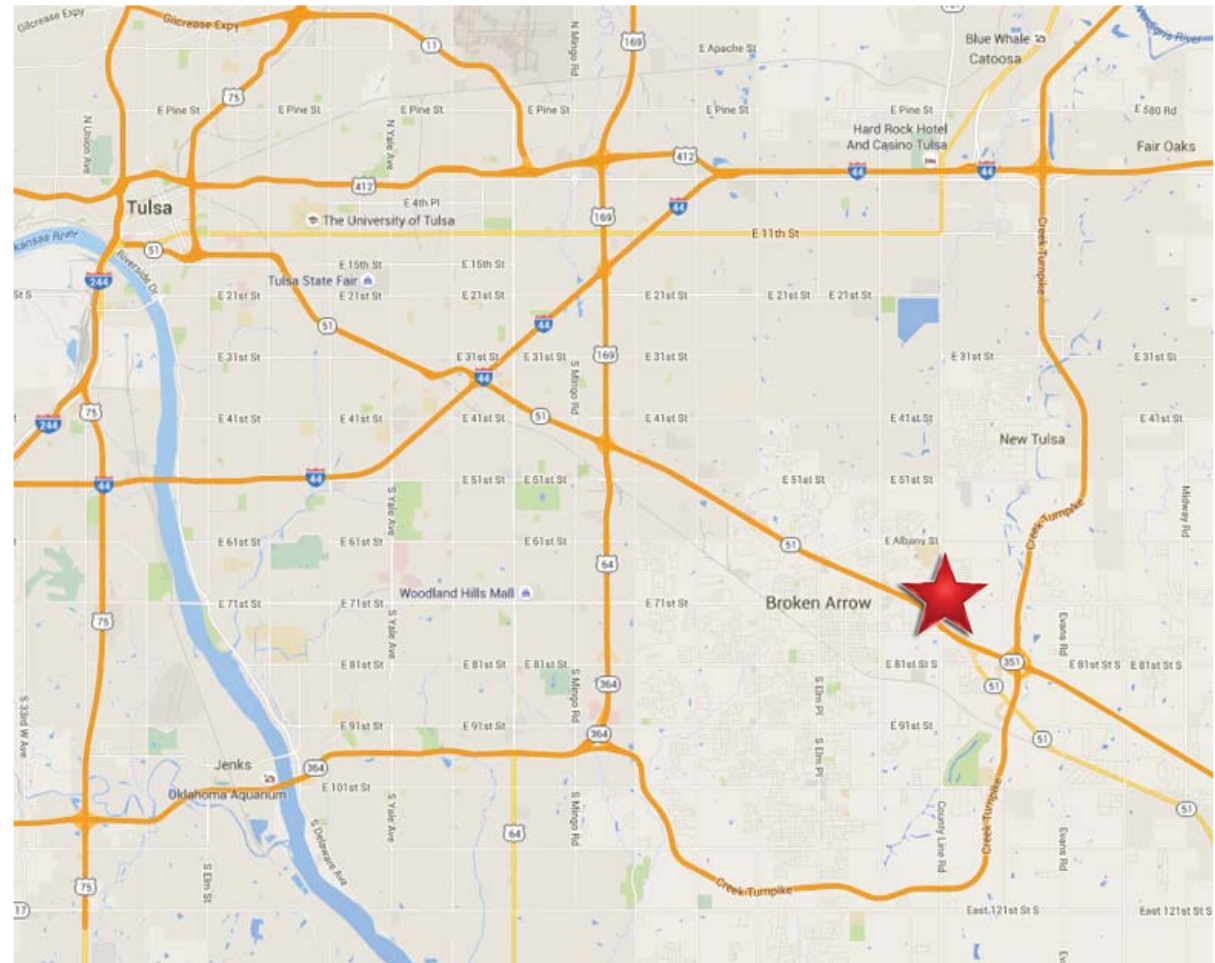

Location
